<p>*Rebuilt Hawaii</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - land destroyed because of wars - people stealing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o told warriors to go back to working in the fields and to fish o turn spears into digging sticks and war canoes into fishing boats - helped to rebuild land - fishponds, irrigation systems, fields 	
<p>*Law of the Splintered Paddle</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Chased innocent fishermen <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Foot stuck on the rock and fisherman struck Kamehameha with a paddle that shattered o Forgave fisherman and gave him land - Created new law that protected weak from strong <ul style="list-style-type: none"> o Women, children and elderly o People could travel safely in Hawaii 	
<p>*Changed Government</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - enforced the kapu system - believed in the religious system and gods to control people - put Governors on every island (people close to him) - kept enemies close to him to keep an eye on them 	

<p>*Protected His People</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- only Kamehameha and closest advisors could do business with foreigners- no foreigners could own land- created Law of Splintered Paddle- stopped the stealing<ul style="list-style-type: none">o told warriors to go home and work again to stop the stealing that was going on for food	
<p>*Taught People</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- became a role-model for people to follow by working alongside them- taught them not to waste, but take what was needed- taught them how to share again by inviting them to take vegetables from his garden- taught them how to correct mistakes from the past<ul style="list-style-type: none">o Law of the Splintered Paddle
