The formative assessment, "Making a Difference in History: Past and Present" will consist of 2 parts. For Part 1, students will create a commemorative plaque honoring Kamehameha I. The plaque will explain how Kamehameha I made a difference after he unified the islands. Students will bullet the main effects of what Kamehameha did as a leader and list down details supporting the main idea. If students are proficient on Part 1, they will then have the option to complete Part 2, "I Made a Difference" booklet, for an opportunity for the Advanced grade. Part 2 will be explained after Part 1 has been graded and returned.

**Part 1 Directions for Commemorative Plaque:**

1. Look through your reading (Kamehameha I Effects After Unification) to help you determine which effects Kamehameha I had.
2. Using the organizer, write a title on the plaque honoring Kamehameha the Great. (Examples: A Local Hero, Making a Difference, History Makers, etc.).
3. Sketch a picture of Kamehameha I or draw a scene showing Kamehameha I in it.
4. Under the picture, write down Kamehameha's name.
5. Under Kamehameha's name, write down the plaque's message: "All of Hawaii should recognize the accomplishments of Kamehameha the Great."
6. Below the message, use Stars to explain the main effects Kamehameha had on the island. Then, use dashes below to support the effects more in detail.
7. Repeat step 6 with another effect Kamehameha had on the islands and dashes to support the effects.
8. **Finally, complete your final by typing everything and drawing and coloring your picture.**
