## **Description of Assessment**

- Students will write a summary of effects of what he did as a leader.

For Part 2, which will be considered Advanced, students will need to show and document how they made a difference in their community.

- Students will need to complete an organizer of how they will made a difference
- Get approval from teacher and from parent/guardian at home
- Complete and document their actions (show proof) using pictures or a letter from the recipient(s) of how the student helped.
- Finally, students will have to complete the Make a Difference Reflection sheet, which includes connections of their contributions to Kamehameha's contributions.
